Make An Olympic Victory Wreath

KEY LEARNING

GOAL OF THE ACTIVITY

Students can make their own victory wreath and put themselves in the shoes of an ancient champion!



WHAT YOU NEED

- Coloured paper
- Cardstock paper
- Ruler
- Scissors
- Glue/sellotape
- Leaf shape stencil (cut out leaf shape from cardboard for younger students)

TIME

~20-30mins

DIRECTIONS

Step 1:

Select a coloured paper of your choice, a pencil and a stencil. Trace 12 leaves and cut them out with scissors




Step 2:

Cut out a strip of cardboard paper that will be the right size when wrapped around your head.



Step 3:

Using glue or sellotape stick the leaves on the headband.



Step 4:

Tape your headband together to fit. Your victory wreath is finished!



Step 5: Try it on and pretend to step up to the podium as an ancient champion!
