KEY LEARNING:

Students are asked to imagine the life of an Ancient or Modern day Olympic athlete and create a story around the Games. This will encourage creativity and develop fine motor skills by letting children create their own comic strips using the template below. Students can use the square spaces to draw their own comics, as well as a text-box below each space where students can explain what is happening.

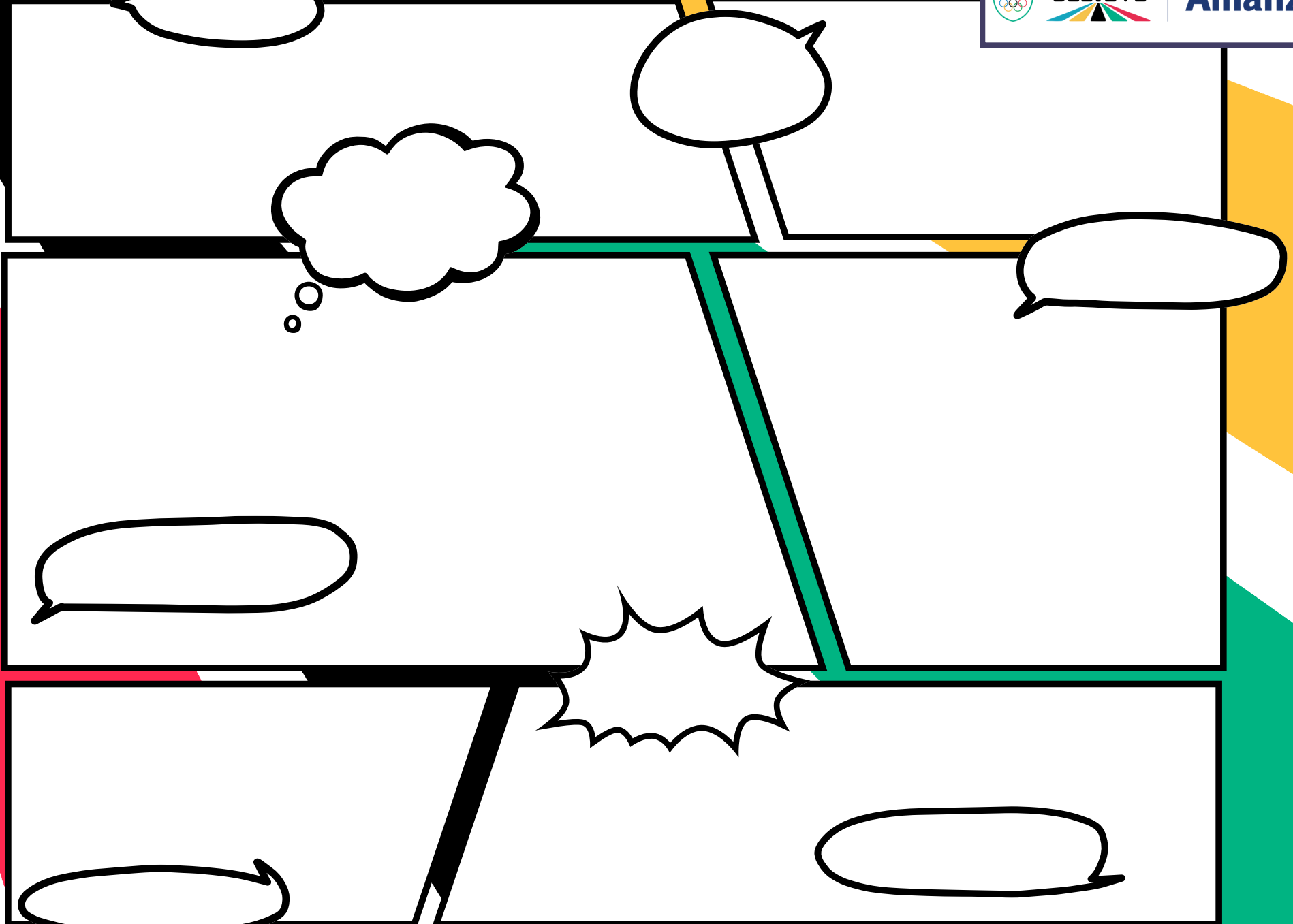
